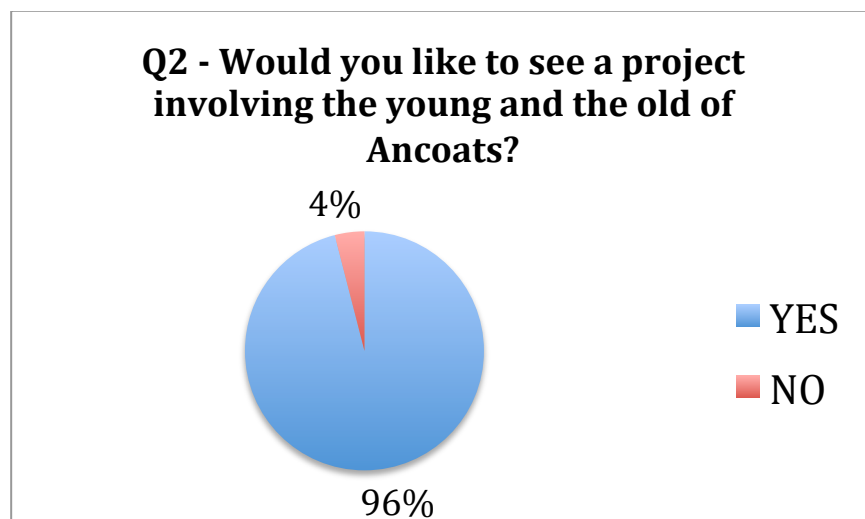

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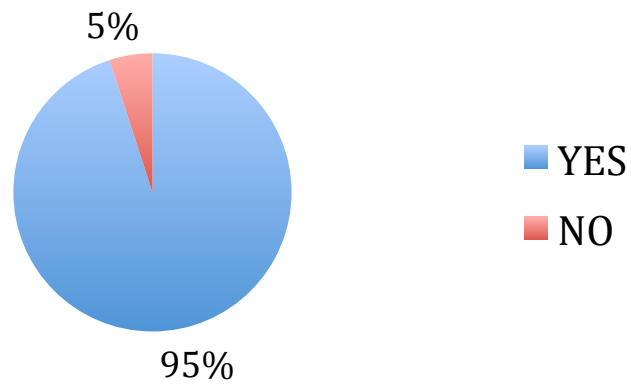
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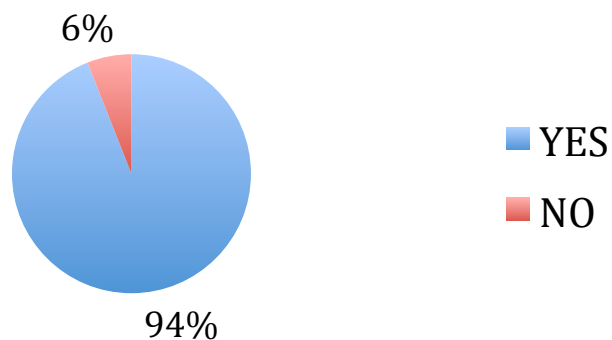
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Q3 - Would you like to see a community cafe in the building?



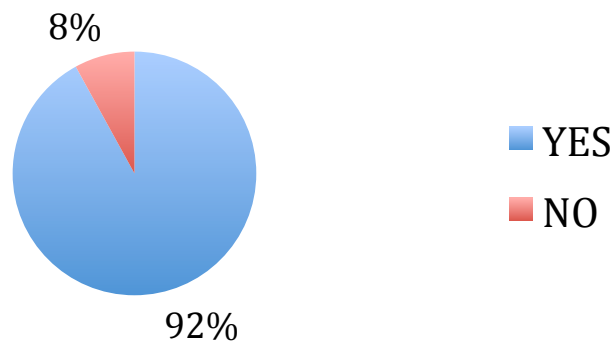
Q4 - Would it be a good idea to have rooms for hire by local groups, societies and clubs?



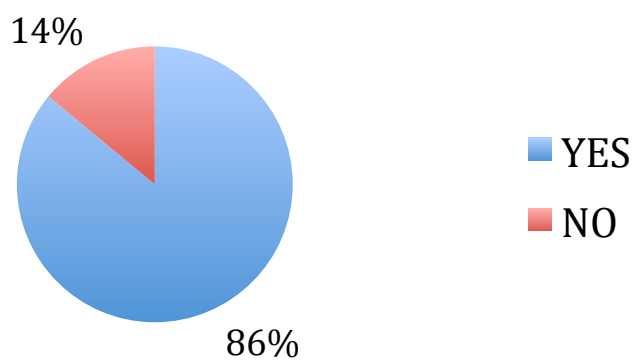
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Q5 - Would the building make an ideal studio space for local artists and crafts people?



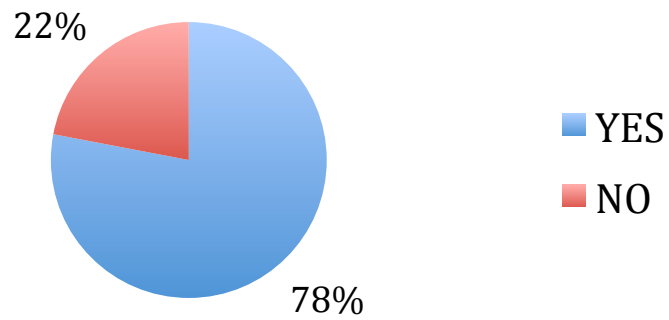
Q6 - Would an interactive medical and social history museum be a good idea?



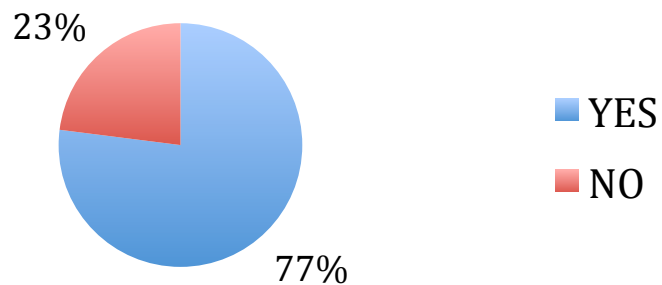
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Q7 - Should a glass-making furnace be installed in the building?
